3.5 Act 2 Status Check

Inquiry 1-Continue working on our writing to improve our comprehension and understandability. Provide evidence to show tier 1 and tier 2 and tier 3 instruction. Focus on small group instruction. Looked at MAPS data. 87% show

proficiency in math for fall and 88% proficiency in reading on the MAPS assessment for fall.

Inquiry 2- Every teacher is involved in LETRS training this year during all staff development days. Grade level wide common rubrics and assessments. Track writing scores throughout the year.

Inquiry 3-Students feeling like they belong to the school.70% feel they belong--2% higher than district. Nationally we are 90% in belonging.
