1.0 Welcome and Roll Call

3.0 New Items

- **3.1** Meeting minutes from December, 2022 were approved.
- **3.2** Budget: New budget – funds less than expected. 1st grade vacancy for next year pulled. \$182K from last year carried over to next year to balance negatives. Projected enrollment for next year 706 students.
- **3.2** Staffing for 2023-2024(In Budget):
 - SEIF position will be funded for a full school year
 - 2 SPTAs to be extra funded
 - 2 IA's funded for 6 hours
 - \$135,000 allocated for supplies to use in other areas.
 - Rollover from the 22-23 school year will be approx. \$182,000
 - Christy would like to add 1 hour to Char's time.
 - A night custodian was hired for the 2022-2023 school year, but we are currently waiting for Human Resources to clear him for further work in the 2023-2024 school year.
- **3.3** Grading: Team members reviewed a presentation that goes home regarding grading expectations, including late work and re-assessments. There is also a shift to know if students are mastering academic standards, rather than grading behaviors. Homework is considered a

behavior, and therefore will not be graded. It is important for students to know standards in order to build mastery from ascending grade levels.

- The weighting of assessments for the 23-24 school year will remain the same as the current year: Formative 0-20%, Summative 80-100%.
