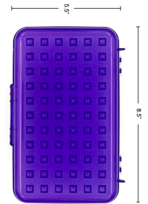
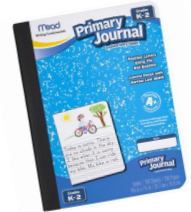




# Mrs. Dickey's Kindergarten Supply List O'Roarke Elementary School

\*Please bring supplies to Teacher Meet & Greet on August 5th

- 1 Box 24-Count Crayola Crayons
- 1 Package 12-Count **TICONDEROGA** #2 Pencils (sharpened would be helpful!)
- 3 Large glue sticks ( .77 oz )
- 1 Package 2-Count Expo, Chisel-Tip, Dry Erase Markers, BLACK
- 1 Package 2-Count Pink Erasers
- 1 Pair Fiskars Blunt-tip kid's scissors (label with child's name)
- 1 Primary Writing Journal, lined, with space at top for picture (label with child's name). This may be difficult to find but we won't use it until September, so don't worry if you are unable to find it.
- 1 Composition Notebook (label with child's name)
- 1 One-subject Spiral Notebook, wide ruled (label with child's name)
- 1 Zipper Pouch for Three-Ring Binder (label with name, place in 1-inch binder)
- One 1-inch Binder with clearview pocket on front, (name on inside)
- 1 Heavy Plastic Pocket Folder, any color (name on inside)
- 1 Plastic Pencil Box, no larger than 9 x 6 x 2.5 in. (label with name)
- Standard-Sized (not toddler) Backpack, no wheels, please
- 1 Pair of Student On-Ear Headphones, not earbuds (label with child's name)

- Change of clothing to be kept in your child's backpack in case of an accident
