



# Mrs. Borchardt's Supply List 2024-2025



\*School supplies may be brought to school if you attend a "Meet and Greet" session or on the first day of school.

The following items should be labeled using a permanent marker with your child's first name and last initial prior to bringing them to school-

- 1-standard backpack (no wheels)
- 1- insulated lunchbox (if your child will be bringing their lunch from home)
- 1- computer mouse WITH cord
- 1- set of headphones (no earbuds, please)
- 1- box of 24 count Crayola crayons (please, no more than 24 count)
- 1- package of 8 Crayon Multicultural crayons
- 1- pair of Fiskar blunt tip children's scissors
- \$8.00 for Scholastic News (envelope with child's name)**

**Extra clothing in a Ziplock baggie (underwear, socks, pants, and shirt—to be kept in their backpack in case of emergencies or lunchroom spills). This is super important for all students.**

The following items should NOT be labeled with your child's name, as they will be shared supplies-

- 1- ream of white or pastel colored copy paper and/or cardstock
- 1 package of regular sized #2 pencils (preferably Ticonderoga brand/pre-sharpened)
- 6 or more- large Elmer's glue sticks (.77 oz.)
- 2 or more black Expo chisel tip or fine tip dry erase markers
- 1- roll of paper towel- boys only
- 1- box of tissues-girls only
- 1- box of Ziploc bags (boys-gallon size/girls-sandwich size)
- 1- container Clorox Wipes
