Children in Transition

Serving students who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence

If you are an unaccompanied youth or your family lives in any of the following situations:

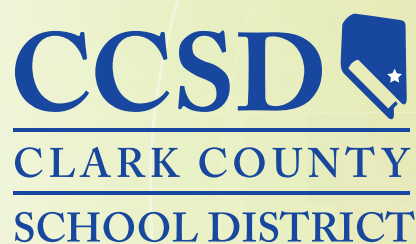
- You live with friends or relatives due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason;
- You live in a hotel or motel due to lack of alternative accommodations;
- You live in an emergency shelter or transitional shelter;
- You live in a car, park, on the street, or similar settings.

Then notify your current school, because you have certain rights and protections under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act.

The Law allows students to:

- Enroll and attend classes while awaiting:
 - » A birth certificate
 - » Immunization records
 - » Address verification
 - » School records
- Choose from the following enrollment options:
 - » Remain at the school of origin (school the child attended before becoming homeless);
 - » Remain at the school last attended while homeless;
 - » Attend the school for which the student's residence is zoned.
- Receive transportation to the "school of origin" or the last school attended by CCSD school bus or RTC bus pass, if in the best interest of the student.
- Receive the same special programs and services, if needed, as provided to all other students
- Receive priority enrollment in state funded pre-k programs

Notify the school office when you move and, if needed, initiate transportation back to the school of origin or last school attended.
