- o Inquiry 1: Our goal is to increase the percentage of students above the 40th percentile. The fall MAPS assessment showed that 81% of students are above 40th percentile. The school is doing a school wide incentive for students: students will know their projected score, and there are prizes for students who met this goal.
- o Inquiry 2: Students are given six writing tasks a year that are used to track their growth. Teachers are focusing on writing and conventions as a student cannot pass SBAC without proficient writing.
- o Inquiry 3: All students grades 3-5 take the Panorama survey. Lorie Harris talks to those students who indicate that they need help.
